Gifts of Art

On rare occasions, the Foundation accepts professionally appraised gifts of art. On these occasions, the Foundation works with the donor to effectively steward the gift, including detailing insurance, copyright and resale agreements.

Why we no longer accept furniture and household items

Over the years, St. Paul's Hospital has learned that gifts of this nature, while delivered with the best of intentions, often place an added and unintentional administrative burden on the Hospital. The gifts can bring about concerns because they may not: hold up to commercial use, meet safety or infection control standards, have the capacity to be serviced or repaired by our suppliers, and a host of other issues. Therefore, the Hospital has determined they will **no longer** accept donations of furniture and household items such as blankets, toasters, housewares, furniture and similar items.

Gifts of Clothing

Patients whose clothing may have been compromised during emergency treatment may need clothing to wear home.

Volunteer Workforce will accept a limited amount of clean, loose fitting appropriate clothing such as sweatpants, t-shirts, socks and slip-on shoes.

Business wear, formal wear and under garments are not accepted.

Gifts of Flowers and Vases

St. Paul's Hospital will often receive large donations of flowers and vases from weddings or other events.

Because staff or volunteers are required to arrange and/or deliver flowers, these gifts are not always accepted.
